The maximum number of entries accepted for this event will be 20 cars. Please enter early.

STO cars as defined by the SCCA GCR (General Competition Rules), SCCA Club Rules are available in the "Club Racing" section of scca.com:

All STO cars must have in their possession a current SCCA Club Log Book.

NOTE: SCCA Pro Racing has final right of refusal of any STO entry.

REGISTRATION:

Entry Fee \$900.

Register using the registration form available on the website. A W9 must also be filed.

SCCA Pro Racing will provide registration services and event credentials for the (STO) portion of the Event, Five (5) credentials total to include: driver plus four (4) crew credentials. Additional over crew credentials will be available for purchase at registration.

Crewmembers requiring hot pit access must be current SCCA members, or may apply for the SCCA annual (\$80) or single event (\$35) temporary membership.

All drivers must be SCCA members, and hold a current FIA or SCCA Pro Racing License, or SCCA Provisional License. A single race discounted pro license available for \$70 from SCCA Pro Racing contact Robin Prill rprill@sccapro.com

ADDITIONAL TECHNICAL ITEMS FOR CARS/DRIVER:

SCCA Pro Racings additional safety equipment are listed under Appendix B "General Technical & Safety Inspection" of the PRR. Some of these items are Hans Devices, center safety net, full face helmets, scatter shields, additional driver suit upgrades, 6 pt safety harness, fire system, etc. Be sure to review all items listed in Appendix B.

EVENT POINTS:

Points for this event will be the same as the Trans Am series. See PRR Article: 5.2.2.1 for the point's structure.

VEHICLE NUMBER DISPLAY:

See PRR Article 5.3 in regards to vehicle number size and placement.

PADDOCK PARKING:

See Event Supplementary Regulations for pre-event staging and parking information. Do not attempt to enter and park on your own. All vehicles competing in the Trans-Am will be parked under the direction of SCCA Pro Racing.
